Apartment Health & Safety Expectations

As a resident you are expected to:

- Be sure you can open and close all doors without obstruction
- Make sure you have a clear walking path of at least 3 feet.
Can a stretcher fit if there was an emergency?
- Make sure there is no clutter in front of windows and be sure you can get to them in an emergency
- Keep kitchen countertops and stove free of flammable products (i.e. paper, plastic containers, etc.).
- Maintain unobstructed access to bathroom facilities including bathtub/shower.
- Maintain all heating sources free and clear of any papers, cardboard boxes or flammable products.
